10K IN TWO 5K LOOPS
LOOP 1 RATED 1A/LOOP 2 RATED 2A**

Participants will drive nine miles from Wallace on I-90 westbound to Kellogg. The starting point is at the Silver Valley Chamber of Commerce (historic railroad depot), 10E. Station Street, Kellogg, Idaho 83837

Loop 1 will take the participant on a route through a residential area, to the Miner's Hat Realty (Photo Op for this unique structure), by the Silver Mountain Resort, Park and Veteran's Memorial before returning to the Chamber of Commerce.

Loop 2 will take the participant up the hills and through residential as well as old business areas in this mining town before dropping down to the park and Veteran's Memorial before returning to the start/finish.

PULASKI TUNNEL TRAIL

SANCTION #: 113806

11K WITH A 6K OPTION RATED 3C

The route from the Wallace Inn will take the participant along the west edge of Wallace out to the Pulaski Tunnel Trail Trailhead. The distance from the Wallace Inn to the Trailhead is 1.5 miles (2.5K). This portion of the route is paved. The restroom building at the trailhead is the only one along the route.

For those wishing to only walk on the Pulaski Tunnel Trail there are a few parking spots at the trailhead.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO:

Allow two to four hours for the four-mile round trip to the Pulaski Tunnel overlook. The trail's first 725 feet are paved and accessible. The trail then gains 800 feet in elevation to the overlook. Several benches line the trail, but drinking water is not available.

HISTORIC WALLACE

Participants will walk through this mining community that has been placed, in its entirety, on the National Registry of Historic Places. The walk will take you past many commercial and residential buildings rich with Wallace history and climb down one of the historic staircases as well as a short distance on the Trail of the Coeur d'Alenes..
