EAST WENATCHEE WALK

10K Rated 2+

Restrooms at start and finish

Not suitable for wheelchairs or some strollers.

Pets on leash are allowed but please be courteous and pick up after your pet.

From Cedars INN carefully cross the Valley Mall Parkway at the Intersection that is a 4-way Stop, turn left to 11th Street and turn right.

Please notice the bridge crossing the river. This was the first bridge to carry a state highway across the Columbia River in 1908. It was used by autos, wagons, and pedestrians, but no railroads. It had two irrigations pipelines on its side which carried irrigation water. The bridge is now a pedestrian bridge that connects Douglas and Chelan counties, and it still carries irrigation water.

Follow 11th to Baker Street where you will cross the street, turn left and continue on Baker to 15th and turn right.

Continue on 15th Street to Eastmont Avenue

Proceed right on Eastmont to 9th Street stop light, cross Eastmont and turn left, proceed to 10th Street

Follow 10th Street to the corner of 10th & Grover. There you will see an Asphalt path about 6 feet from the road, follow this path that runs parallel to 10th to Iowa Street. Stay on 10th to the Evergreen Memorial Park Cemetery.

Cross 10th Street and enter the cemetery walking past the office (you will be walking clockwise on the loop in the cemetery). Walk to the 3rd right and bear right to the mausoleum (which will be on your left). Turn right and return back to the entrance.

Cross 10th onto Jennifer Street. Continue on Jennifer to 6th Street. Turn Right (1 block) to James. Turn right on James (porta potty in Kenroy Park). Cross 8th and turn left and follow 8th Street where you will walk past the Eastmont Junior High School and the Japanese Gardens. 8th Street curves and becomes 9th Street. Cross Eastmont and then 9th Street continuing on Eastmont past the firehouse to 3rd Street.

Take a right and go to Valley Mall Parkway. Follow Valley Mall Parkway to 9th Street, (Wenatchee Valley Mall will be on your right side). Proceed to 9th Street and cross 9th, then cross Valley Mall Parkway. You are now back at the
