**DIRECTIONS:** From west on Hwy 12, cross White Pass, continue 33 miles east past milepost 183. From north and east, leave Yakima going west on Hwy 12, pass Naches to intersection of Hwy 12 & 410. Bear left toward White Pass on Hwy 12 for about 2 miles to Oak Creek Wildlife office (elk feeding location). If Chinook Pass is open, Hwy 410 is a shorter, scenic path from Seattle/Tacoma--turn right at Hwy 12.
