CHALLENGES

ESVA: ~~County (Douglas), Town (Bakery), Park (City Park)~~ ^{W2T Sch}

NOTE: Public restrooms are only available in the city park next to the start point.
Pets must be on leash at all times, please be courteous and clean up after pets

1. Walk thru City Park, 1 block to Hwy 2
NOTE: The Waterville hotel on the other side of the Hwy was built in 1903.
2. Left on Hwy 2, Follow sidewalk until it ends at Beech Street
NOTE: The mural on the south wall of the Museum. This is a very nice museum if you wish to take the time to visit.
3. Left on Beech Street to stop sign at S. Chelan Ave.
4. Left on Chelan Avenue to Hwy 2 known as Locust St, (Main Street of town).
5. Left on Locust and follow until it dead ends at Jackson St.
6. Right on Jackson to ~~West~~ Third St. ^{NE}
7. Right on West Third to stop sign at Chelan Avenue
8. Right on Chelan to Locust St. (stay on right side of road)
9. Left at Locust, crossing Hwy at crosswalk.
10. Follow Locust past swimming pool to Monroe St.
11. Right on Monroe St. one block to Walnut St.
12. Right on Walnut two blocks to S. Rainier (no sign)
13. Left on S. Rainier one block to Birch St.
NOTE: The beautiful old courthouse building which was built in 1905 and is still in use for county offices. Take time to walk inside and see the historical photographs on the walls.
14. Left on Birch St one block to Adams St.
15. Left on Adams St. one block to Walnut St.
16. Right on Walnut one block to Monroe St.
17. Right on Monroe one block to Birch St.
18. Left on Birch to the end. Look for a paved road to the right with 3 mailboxes, with a horse cutout on the top. (Gormley St.)
19. Take this road and follow until it dead ends at a gravel road (Elm St. unmarked)
20. Turn right and follow downhill until you come to a cemetery entrance on your left.
21. Enter the cemetery and follow to end
22. Turn right, then right again to follow the cemetery road back to Elm St.
23. Left on Elm St to stop sign at S. Chelan St.
24. Left on S. Chelan walking on the left side, until you see a gravel road on the left which leads uphill to the old water tower.
25. Walk up to the water tower and enjoy the views of Waterville and the surrounding wheat fields.
26. Return to the paved road, carefully cross to the other side and follow back to the start point
