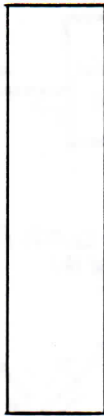

DIRECTIONS - GREENWAY "SEASONAL BIKE EVENT"

7. Go thru signal light and turn left on main highway (Hwy 24). Cross with caution. Continue over bridge--okay to walk bike over bridge. Turn left on Keys Road /Sportsman's State Park exit (first left). **Use extreme caution on Hwy 24 when turning left on Keys Road.** Follow Keys Road to the entrance to Sportsman's State Park. Turn left into Park.

8. Stay on road to right. (Enjoy the ducks and geese.) You will pass a parking lot and restrooms on your right. Past the restrooms, turn right into campground area. Turn onto the left road and make a loop through the campground and exit. Turn right on main Park road. Playground on right. Turn right on Park entrance road and another right on Keys Road. (You have gone 10K.)

9. Proceed to end of Keys Road. Turn right on Hwy 24. Continue back across bridge to signal light and turn right. Turn right on Birchfield Road, left into the parking lot and right onto the Greenway pathway.

10. Stay on the pathway. You will pass Sarge Hubbard Park again; this time on your left. When you reach the underpass, you have gone 15K.

11. Continue past Rio Mirada and the Rotary Lake parking area. You will find restrooms on your right. Go under the two bridges and stay on pathway to the right along metal railing. As you head around Bergland Lake, you have gone 20K. **CHECKPOINT AHEAD.**

12. Go to end of pathway around Bergland Lake (exits into parking lot). Turn around. Painted on pathway in white paint are two words. In **Box 2 above, write down these two words.**

13. Continue back on the same path and return to Rio Mirada Motel. You have just completed 25K.

Please leave your Start Card in the file box at the lobby desk and obtain your Credit stamp and/or award.

1. The bike event starts behind the Rio Mirada. Exit the Rio Mirada and start your biking event on the Greenway paved trail behind the motel. Turn right on the pathway and proceed in a southeasterly direction.

2. Stay on the main pathway with the Yakima River on your left. When you reach Sarge Hubbard Park, stay on the main path; however, there are restrooms and water available to your right.

3. Proceed on the main pathway to Sherman Park. The Humane Shelter Building and restrooms will be on your left.

4. Turn left through parking lot out to road. This is Birchfield Road, but is not marked. Turn right on roadway and proceed down road to the Arboretum. Go to the end of the parking lot (blacktopped area) and turn around. If you wish to visit the Arboretum, the hours are from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

5. Proceed back on same road and continue past the Humane Shelter and also Nob Hill Auto Wrecking (on left). Proceed thru road blocks and straight ahead to Robertson's Landing. Restrooms on your right. **This is Checkpoint 1. Read the plaque at the landing and write down in Box 1 above the number of tons of rock and sediment that are carried down the Yakima River each year.**

6. Leaving the landing stay on pathway to left, proceeding on path toward the river and then back to the right. When you come to the parking lot, turn left. Continue on path until you come to underpass. Turn around and go back on the same path and continue until you come to wood fence. Turn left. Continue down road with Auto Wrecking on right, until you reach signal light. (Note: at this point you have gone 5K).
